The City of Haysville is supportive of SB 196 recognizing the positive impact the bill will have on cities and their residents. Reinstating the statutory transfer from the State General Fund to the Local Ad Valorem Tax Reduction Fund would provide another avenue for the City of Haysville to lower its mill rate. Due to conversative budget policy and effective cost controls, Haysville lowered its mill rate by 3.47 mills during the 2024 budget process.
