Thank you for the opportunity to testify in opposition of Senate Bill 468 on behalf of the City of Shawnee.

As proposed, this legislation would harm cities, businesses, and residents by challenging local efforts of economic development through job creation and redevelopment of blighted areas unique to each community.

Associating economic incentive tools to the Revenue Neutral Rate process could result in significant negative impacts to taxing jurisdictions across the state and would not bolster the intended efforts of transparency or accountability as it relates to the property tax process.
