Subject: Senate Bill No. 2

Summary

Senate Bill No. 2 provides that individuals who were found to have revoked driver's licenses as a result of driving a motor vehicle when such person's license was canceled, suspended or revoked for failure to comply with a traffic citation may apply for restricted driving privileges. Individuals would not qualify for the restricted driving privileges if such person has been convicted for driving with a cancelled, suspended or revoked license more than three times. The Division of Motor Vehicles is instructed to rescind the restricted driving privileges if the person is found guilty of another violation that results in a suspension, revocation or cancellation.
