

Traditional Lottery Revenue Distribution

The first 50.0 million is split four ways:

- 1) \$100,000 is transferred to the Problem Gambling and Addictions Grant Fund (KSA 79-4806);
- 2) 85.0 percent is transferred to the Economic Development Initiatives Fund (KSA 79-4804);
- 3) 10.0 percent is transferred to the Correctional Institutions Building Fund (KSA 79-4803); and
- 4) 5.0 percent is transferred to the Juvenile Alternatives to Detention Fund (KSA 79-4803).

From the remaining balance, veterans' programs receive a set transfer of \$1.2 million.

Up to \$8.0 million in net profit of self-service ticket vending machines is transferred to mental health programs.

The remaining funds, after these transfers, are deposited into the State General Fund, which has averaged \$22.3 million over the last 12 years.
