
**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2156 by House Committee on Energy, Utilities, and Telecommunications

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2156 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2156 would allow the Kansas Corporation Commission to approve utility rates that benefit low-income residential customers. The bill would not require public utility companies to propose such rates.

The Kansas Corporation Commission and the Citizens' Utility Ratepayer Board indicate that enactment of HB 2156 would not have a fiscal effect on agency operations.
