7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:
8	Section 1. K.S.A. 21-5407 is hereby amended to read as follows: 21-
9	5407. (a) Assisting suicide is:
10	(1) Knowingly, by force or duress, causing another person to commit
11	or attempt to commit suicide; or
12	(2) intentionally assisting another person to commit or to attempt to
13	commit suicide by:
14	(A) Providing the physical means by which another person commits
15	or attempts to commit suicide; or
16	(B) participating in a physical act by which another person commits
17	or attempts to commit suicide;
18	(3) intentionally advising or encouraging another person to commit
19	or attempt to commit suicide that causes such person to commit or attempt
20	to commit suicide; or
21	(4) intentionally advising or encouraging another person to commit
22	or attempt to commit suicide.
23	(b) Assisting suicide as defined in:
24	(1) Subsection (a)(1) is a severity level 3, person felony;-and
25	(2) subsection (a)(2) or (a)(3) is a severity level-9 7, person felony;
26	and
27	(3) subsection $(a)(4)$ is a class A person misdemeanor.
28	Sec. 2. K.S.A. 21-5407 is hereby repealed.
29	Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
30	publication in the statute book.
