AN ACT concerning criminal procedure; providing that family members of certain deceased crime victims have the right to sit in a designated seating area at or near the prosecution table during certain court proceedings; amending K.S.A. 2022 Supp. 22-3436 and repealing the existing section.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 2022 Supp. 22-3436 is hereby amended to read as follows: 22-3436. This section applies (a) If a defendant is charged with a crime pursuant to articles described in article 54, 55 or 56 of chapter 21 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated, or K.S.A. 2022 Supp. 21-6104, 21-6325, 21-6326 or 21-6418 through 21-6422, and amendments thereto-:

- $\frac{\text{(a)}(1)}{\text{(b)}}$ The prosecuting attorney, as defined in K.S.A. 22-2202, and amendments thereto, shall:
- $\frac{(1)}{(A)}$ Inform the victim or the victim's family before any dismissal or declining of prosecuting charges;
- $\frac{(2)}{(B)}$ inform the victim or the victim's family of the nature of any proposed plea agreement; and
- (3)(C) inform and give notice to the victim or the victim's family of the rights established in subsection (b). (a)(2); and
- $\frac{\text{(b)}(2)}{\text{(b)}(2)}$ the victim of a crime or the victim's family have the right to be present at any hearing where a plea agreement is reviewed or accepted and the parties may submit written arguments to the court prior to the date of the hearing.
- (b) If a defendant is charged with a crime described in article 54 of chapter 21 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated, and amendments thereto, and the victim of such crime is deceased, one member of the victim's family shall have the right to sit in a designated seating area at or near the prosecution table during any court proceeding at which the defendant has a right to be present, to the extent that such right to sit in such area does not interfere with the constitutional or statutory rights of the defendant. The victim's family shall choose the family member who will sit in such area and inform the prosecuting attorney of such choice at or prior to the first court proceeding at which the family member will exercise such right. The prosecuting attorney shall inform the court of such choice for the record. The court on its own motion or upon request may change the
