1 AN ACT concerning elections; relating to voter registration; requiring the
2 assignment of registered voters whose residence has no corresponding
3 mailing address to the voting precinct where such voter resides;
4 amending K.S.A. 25-2305a and repealing the existing section.

6 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

7 Section 1. K.S.A. 25-2305a is hereby amended to read as follows: 25-
8 2305a. (a) The county election officer shall record and maintain a
9 residential address and a mailing address for each registered voter if the
10 mailing address is different from the residential address. The residential
11 address of a registered voter shall correspond to a physical location where
12 the registered voter resides and shall not be a post office box or other
13 address that does not correspond to a physical location that can be
14 occupied and, if not, the person shall not be considered a validly registered
15 voter. The county election officer shall record such information in any
16 electronic database.

17 (b) *For any registered voter whose residence is a physical location*
18 *for which there is no corresponding mailing address, the county election*
19 *officer shall assign such voter to the voting precinct in which such voter's*
20 *residence is located.*

21 (c) *For purposes of this section, "residence" means the same as*
22 *defined in K.S.A. 25-407, and amendments thereto.*

23 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 25-2305a is hereby repealed.

24 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
25 publication in the statute book.
