The Senate was called to order pro forma by President Ty Masterson.

## REFERENCE OF BILLS AND CONCURRENT RESOLUTIONS

The following bill was referred to Committee as indicated:

Judiciary: **HB 2329**.

## REFERENCE OF APPOINTMENTS

The following appointment was referred to Committee as indicated:

Judiciary: **Lori Bolton Fleming**, Judge, Kansas Court of Appeals.

## CHANGE OF REFERENCE

The President withdrew **Sub HB 2060** from the Committee on **Federal and State Affairs**, and referred the bill to the Committee on **Local Government, Transparency and Ethics**.

## REPORTS OF STANDING COMMITTEES

Committee on **Commerce** recommends **HB 2037**, **HB 2291**, **HB 2338** be passed.

Also, **HB 2088**, As Amended by House Committee of the Whole, be amended on page 1, in line 12, by striking "New"; in line 19, by striking "New"; in line 26, by striking all after "permit";

On page 2, in line 16, by striking "New";

On page 4, in line 10, by striking "New"; by striking all in lines 21 through 43;

By striking all on page 5;

On page 6, by striking all in lines 1 through 12;

On page 8, by striking all in line 32;

And by renumbering sections accordingly;

On page 1, in the title, in line 3, by striking "and other required approvals"; in line 8, by striking all after "waiver"; in line 9, by striking all before the period; and the bill be passed as amended.

Committee on **Local Government, Transparency and Ethics** recommends **SB 66** be amended by substituting with a new bill to be designated as "Substitute for SENATE BILL NO. 66," as follows:

"Substitute for SENATE BILL NO. 66

By Committee on Local Government, Transparency and Ethics

"AN ACT concerning local governmental ethics; relating to filing requirements of the

statement of substantial interests; requiring annual filing by city or county elected or appointed officials; providing that elected or appointed officials of a governmental subdivision other than a city or county file statements of substantial interests if any change in substantial interests occurred; requiring governmental officials with a substantial interest in a real estate development project to verbally disclose such interest prior to first participating in any discussion, review or action on a proposed zoning change or permit; amending K.S.A. 75-4302a and repealing the existing section.";

And the substitute bill be passed.
