A resident will hunt 3-4 hours and go home these guys are hunting daylight to dark everyday and ducks do not respond to that kind of pressure constantly being applied. I am a 45 yr volunteer in a major waterfowl conservation group and I feel we need to give these birds a break from this type of overhunting. This kind of pressure will at some point destroy all waterfowl hunting in this state and then what about all that revenue that will be lost as a conservationist first i ask for yourself support to try and save the waterfowl hunting heritage we have in Kansas thank you
