12	school district that are regulated, supervised, promoted and developed by	
13	the activities association referred to in K.S.A. 72-7114, and amendments

16	(2) Participation in such activities includes participation in ancillary	
17	activities, events and programs associated with any activity described in	
18	paragraph (1). Ancillary activities include, but are not limited to, pep	
19	rallies, award or honor ceremonies, lettering events, yearbook or other	
20	promotional functions and other events or programs promoting an activity	
21	described in paragraph (1) or honoring students who participate in any	
22	such activity.	
23	(3)(b) A student shall be permitted to participate in any such activities

(B) the parent, teacher or organization that provides instruction to the
student submits an affidavit or transcript to the activities association
indicating the student meets the academic eligibility requirements of
