To Chair Proctor and Members of the Committee:

HB 2438 will take away control of election officials

This bill bans local election officials from accepting online voter registration from anywhere the Secretary of State hasn't personally endorsed.

HB 2438 would allow the Secretary of State to ban any online voter registration tool for no reason.

Under this law there would be no rules or regulations required until after the 2026 elections.

The law as stated would go into effect immediately, but there would be no rules or regulations required for online registration tools to follow in order to be endorsed by the Secretary of State until after the 2026 elections.
