

Written opponent testimony on HB 2438

Members of the Committee,

I am opposed to HB 2438. The bill as written does not provide a structure or framework for the Secretary of State to fairly and transparently assess online voter registration tools. This leaves any ban up to the sole discretion of the Secretary of State, while not providing any fair framework for online voter registration sites to follow to be in compliance.

Tools that more easily enable citizens to register to vote should be the norm. While ideally these would be created by the state, this is not always the case; sites like ksvotes.org provide a valuable civil service and have been doing so for years. Please do not pass this bill, which does not solve a problem but will instead make it harder for citizens to register to vote.
