

To whom it may concern:

I have three big concerns with HB 2438:

- It allows the Secretary of State to ban any online voter registration tool for no reason at all
- It takes away local control of election officials by banning them from accepting online voter registration from anywhere the SOS hasn't personally endorsed
- This law would go into effect immediately, but there would be no rules or regulations required for online voter registration tools to follow in order to be endorsed by the SOS until after the 2026 elections

At a time when politicians should be making it easier for citizens to vote,

- This bill would make it more complicated by banning secure online tools that help citizens register to vote and participate in our state's elections.
- Instead of doing their job to make it easier to participate in our democracy, politicians are trying to rig the system in their favor. They want to change voter registration rules right before an election. This silences voters and makes voting tougher for everyone.
- When elected leaders failed to make an online voter registration tool that works for regular people, civic leaders stepped up and built ksvotes.org. Now, they want to ban it. [Ksvotes.org](https://ksvotes.org) is a safe and secure online tool for voter registration. It has been used securely for almost a decade and helped countless Kansans register to vote.

Therefore, I wish to register my opposition to HB 2438.
