Subject: HB 2446-Summary

HB 2446 amends two statutes dealing with the crime of corrupt political advertising to delete the requirement that the name of the treasurer of an organization be listed in political advertisements.

K.S.A. 25-2407 is part of the general election crimes. It would cover elected officials of cities of the second and third class (599 cities) unified school districts other than the Wichita school district, townships, community colleges and various other local units of government.

K.S.A. 25-4156 is part of the campaign finance act which act covers elected officials of the state, cities of the first class (26 out of 625 cities), counties, school districts with an enrollment of 35,000 or more (USD 259-Wichita) and the board of public utilities.
