Chairman Kessler and Members of the Committee,

The bill before you today creates a framework for the Kansas State Legislature to choose and instruct its commissioners to an Article V convention for proposing amendments. I believe that our nation is approaching, in the near future, its first-ever Article V convention, and it is prudent for the state to put these procedures in place in advance.

I support this bill and would be happy to answer any questions the committee may have about Article V and its processes. Thank you for allowing me to testify today.
