HB 2065 is absurd: you don't select Delegates to an Art. V Convention! And beware of HCR 5001 & all other applications for a Convention

Congress decides the number and selection process for the Delegates. <u>State</u>
<u>Legislatures have no power to select or control Delegates.</u> So any pretended Delegate selection & control bill (such as HB 2065) is a sham.

Furthermore, <u>Chiafalo v. Washington</u> isn't about controlling Delegates to an Article V Convention. <u>Chiafalo</u> addressed Presidential Electors casting their vote for President of the United States contrary to what they were pledged to do. That case has nothing to do with Delegates to an Article V Convention, who, <u>as our Declaration of Independence</u> and <u>James Madison expressly recognized</u>, have the "self-evident" right to throw off one government and set up a new one.

And did you know that a "COS" Board Member has already co-authored a new Constitution which creates a new federal government with massive new powers?

So Oppose HCR 5001 & all other applications for Congress to call a convention - and rescind the Applications Kansas already sent to Congress.
