Subject: SB 13-Summary

SB 13 would eliminate several filing requirements with the Office of the Secretary of State and make several conforming and technical changes.

The bill would provide:

- Business agents of a labor organization would no longer be required to file the entity's constitution, bylaws, and annual reports.
- Employee organizations would no longer be required to file copies of their bylaws or governing rules;
- The State Board of Regents would no longer be required to file reciprocal agreements for use of educational facilities:
- The Secretary of Revenue would no longer be required to file annual reports related to tax abatement of motor carrier ad valorem tax liabilities, income tax compromises, and delinquent personal corporate income tax
- The Director of the Kansas Water Office would no longer be required to file copies of stream bank easements and
- Bonded warehousemen would no longer be required to be licensed by, or file with, the Office of the Secretary of State.
