While this bill claims information will remain confidential, sensitive personal data will still be collected and shared with law enforcement and the federal background check system. This creates potential privacy and security risks and is a burden on healthcare providers.

The bill relies on healthcare providers to verify identity, but does not outline clear safeguards against fraud. Someone could present a fake ID and request to be added to the list, leading to wrongful firearm prohibitions.

There is no process to ensure individuals are making this decision free from pressure or coercion. A person in crisis or under duress could be influenced into signing away their rights.
