**MEMORANDUM**

**Re:** H.B. 2511, As introduced; Permitting moneys received from agricultural production on a state-owned property to be used for the management of all state-owned properties.

---

Under K.S.A. 32-809, all moneys received from agricultural production on state-owned property under the control and jurisdiction of the secretary of wildlife and parks are credited to the state agricultural product fund. The statute requires the department to create separate accounts in the fund for each such state-owned property. Each account's funds must be used to maintain the property associated with such account.

H.B. 2511 would amend K.S.A. 32-809 to state that the moneys in each account can be used for the management of all state-owned properties.

H.B. 2511 would become effective upon publication in the statute book.
