Geriatric House Calls[™] Optimize Functional Wellness for Complex Older Adults and Increases Patient Satisfaction

HIGHER FUNCTION EQUALS LOWER COST OF HEALTH CARE

Peer-reviewed publication (N=38,203) demonstrated significant reduction health care cost with higher PSFS scores (19:146. https://doi.org/10.1186/s12877-019-1147-6)



- 36% IMPROVEMENT N = 266,000

Patient Specific Functional Scale

Individualized outcome measure that focuses on patient-centered limitations. Lack of progress is linked to adverse health outcomes.

Patient satisfaction scores of 98% "recommend to friend/family" as compared to CMS Home Health average scores of 79%



What We're Asking For

 FOX Rehabilitation is seeking to add an exception from licensing requirements to K.S.A. § 65-5101for entities providing therapy services by licensed therapy professionals for non-Medicare Part A outpatient therapy services (i.e., non-home health agency/Part B therapy services)

Our Reasoning

- Licensure is an obstacle to higher quality patient care and more costefficient care for both patients and payors
- FOX provides only therapy services, and if licensed as a home care agency, could **generate confusion** with Kansans regarding which benefit they are using, and their ability to seek skilled nursing services from a separate home care agency, etc.
- FOX's service are sufficiently regulated through the respective licensing boards' oversight
