Subject: Bill Brief on Sub for SB 193

Sub for Senate Bill 193 provides an exception for law enforcement agencies from participation in the statewide opioid antagonist protocol.

SB 193 amends K.S.A. 65-16,127 to include an exception in subsection (f), adding that a law enforcement agency would be exempt from subsection (f) unless such law enforcement agency elects to provide an emergency opioid antagonist pursuant to the protocol in subsection (b).

The bill passed the Senate by a vote of 40-0 and it would go into effect on July 1, 2025, upon publication in the statute book.
