Being able to stay in one place so that I can take care of my family and the home. I am being ask to leave my home again. I have to be here to register to stay compliant and it is very hard to do at times, but it gets done. The cost is hard to do also, but to stay compliant I must find a way to do it. Sometimes, this has almost cost me my employment. After 20+ years I should not have to do it anymore, and be able to get on with my life.
