Our associations support HB2389 creating a statutory provision for the court to consider prior offenses of the listed sex crimes when setting the bond. Repeat offenders of these crimes pose a significant threat to public safety and are more likely to create a willingness to not appear for trial. The victims of these crimes are especially fearful when the offender is not incarcerated pending trial for these very serious crimes.
