## **MEMORANDUM**

Subject: Bill Brief – HB 2029

HB 2029 designates a portion of K-5 highway in Wyandotte County as the Representative Marvin S Robinson II memorial highway.

Section 1 provides that the Representative Marvin S Robinson II memorial highway will be designated on the portion of K-5 highway in Wyandotte County from the junction of K-5 and north 18<sup>th</sup> Street then will go west on K-5 to its junction with north 38<sup>th</sup> street. Highway signs designating the highway as the Representative Marvin S Robinson II memorial highway will not be placed until the requirements of K.S.A. 68-10,114 are met. K.S.A. 68-10,114 provides that the secretary of transportation should not place any signs designating memorial highways until receiving sufficient funds from gifts and donations to cover the costs of those signs. Additionally, the secretary must receive an additional 50% of the initial cost to pay for future maintenance or replacement costs for the signs.

Section 2 resdesignates that same portion of interstate 635, which combines with K-5 highway through this portion of highway, since it was already named to account for the Representative Marvin S Robinson II memorial highway. That portion of highway is currently designated as the Harry Darby memorial highway.
