Subject: Bill Brief – HB 2031

House Bill 2031 permits driving school instructors to possess a motorcycle driver's license from any state.

K.S.A. 8-276 provides the requirements for a person to qualify as a driving school instructor. Currently, one of the requirements for a driving school instructor is that the person must hold a valid Kansas drivers' license.

HB 2031 permits motorcycle driving instructors to possess a valid class M driver's license or an equivalent license allowing such person to operate a motorcycle in another state. The instructor is otherwise required to meet the other qualifications listed in K.S.A. 8-276 for all driving school instructors.

The provisions of HB 2031 become effective on publication in the statute book, or July 1, 2025.
