Subject: Bill Brief – HB 2263

House Bill 2263 designates a future interchange on K-10 Highway as the Kris Norton Memorial Interchange.

HB 2263 provides that the Kris Norton Memorial Interchange will be designated on the interchange that will be constructed as part of the K-10 highway expansion project located at the existing at grade intersection of K-10 highway and Wakarusa drive in Douglas county. Highway signs designating the interchange as the Kris Norton Memorial Interchange will not be placed until the requirements of K.S.A. 68-10,114 are met. K.S.A. 68-10,114 provides that the secretary of transportation should not place any signs designating memorial highways until receiving sufficient funds from gifts and donations to cover the costs of those signs. Additionally, the secretary must receive an additional 50% of the initial cost to pay for future maintenance or replacement costs for the signs.

If enacted, the provisions of HB 2263 become effective upon publication in the statute book, July 1, 2025.
