Subject: Bill Brief on HB 2274

House Bill 2274 removes the active requirement from military servicemembers for occupational licensure.

Sections 1 amends K.S.A. 48-3406 to remove the word “active” before servicemember, once on page 1 and once on page 8. This change would mean that part-time active duty servicemembers or their spouses would be eligible for expedited state licensure from the bodies listed in subsection (v).

HB 2274 would take effect on July 1, 2025, after publication in the statute book.
