Subject: House Bill 2758 - Directing the capitol preservation committee to develop and approve plans for a registry kiosk of Kansas military forces killed in action or who died of wounds incurred during active duty to be placed within the state capitol.

House Bill 2758, as introduced, directs the capitol preservation committee to develop and approve plans for a registry kiosk of Kansas military forces killed in action or who died of wounds incurred during active duty to be placed within the state capitol.

Subsection (a) directs the capitol preservation committee to approve plans to place a permanent registry kiosk within the state capitol of Kansas military forces killed in action or who dies of wounds incurred during active duty.

Subsection (b) authorizes the secretary of administration to receive moneys from grants, gifts, contributions or bequests for the creation and construction of the registry kiosk. No public funds shall be expended for the purpose of financing the creation or construction of the registry kiosk.

Subsection (c) establishes the Kanas military forces registry kiosk fund. Expenditures from such fund may be made for the purposes of creating and constructing the registry kiosk.

House Bill 2758, as introduced, would become effective upon publication in the statute book.
