**MEMORANDUM**

Subject: House Bill 2767 - Establishing the Kansas military affairs commission and prescribing the powers and duties thereof.

House Bill 2767 establishes the Kansas military affairs commission and prescribes the powers and duties of such commission.

On and after July 1, 2026, the governor's military council shall be referred to as the Kansas military affairs commission and the commission shall serve as a continuation of the council.

Subsection (c) provides for the voting members of the commission, including the governor, the Kansas adjutant general, the president of the senate, the speaker of the house the Kansas secretary of commerce, the executive director of the Kansas office of veterans services, three representatives from municipalities that have military installations, one active duty military spouse and three qualified individuals with extensive military experience or expertise.

Members of the commission shall serve three-year terms until they are either reappointed or replaced.

Subsection (f) provides for 11 non-voting members to be appointed by military installations, Kansas educational institutions and the Kansas fusion center.

Subsection (h) provides for the functions, powers and duties of the Kansas military affairs commission, including providing advice, counsel and actionable recommendations on military-affiliated issues and economic and industrial development related to the military to the governor.

House Bill 2767, as introduced, would take effect upon publication in the statute book.
