**MEMORANDUM**

Subject: SB 382—Administration and Proctoring of Statewide Assessments to Virtual School Students

---

Senate Bill 382 would provide for the administration and proctoring of statewide assessments to virtual school students by such students' virtual schools.

Currently, K.S.A. 72-3717 provides the requirements for the administration of virtual statewide assessments. SB 382 would amend K.S.A. 72-3717 to provide that such assessments would be administered by the virtual school and during the same range of dates assigned for the administration of assessments to non-virtual school students enrolled in the same school district.

Additionally, SB 382 would require virtual students taking the statewide assessment virtually to be monitored by an assessment proctor designated by the virtual school. If the assessment platform provides integrated camera proctoring, the virtual school proctor may administer the assessment and monitor such students using the same device. If the assessment platform does not provide integrated camera proctoring, such students shall have a second device with a functioning camera to monitor such students, or the virtual school may provide a second device with a functioning camera upon request of such students.

SB 382 would also provide that the assessment administrator who verifies completed assessments would be designated by the virtual school.

SB 382 would take effect on July 1, 2026, upon publication in the statute book.
