MEMORANDUM

Subject: SB 383—Special Education State Aid Reimbursements to School Districts for Certain Special Teachers

Senate Bill 383 would include certain third parties who contract with school districts to the definition of special teacher and authorize special education state aid reimbursement for qualified teachers who provide approved special education or related services to students with an IEP administered by such school district pursuant to a contract.

Section 1 of SB 383 would amend K.S.A. 72-3404 to include within the definition of "special teacher" persons under contract with a third party that has contracted with a school district.

Section 2 of the bill would amend K.S.A. 72-3422 to state that special education state aid reimbursement would be provided for special teachers who provide approved special education or related services to exceptional children with IEPs administered by the school district to include those special teachers who are under contract with a third party that has contracted with a school district.

The bill also includes technical cleanup of existing statutes.

SB 383 would take effect on July 1, 2026, upon publication in the statute book.
