Proponent Testimony for HB 2048

February 25, 2025

Chairwoman Dietrich and Members of the Committee,

Thank you for the opportunity to testify in support of House Bill 2048.

House Bill 2048 amends K.S.A. 40-2,125, which governs the Department of Insurance's enforcement over regulated entities. The bill simplifies this definition and strikes the list of specific entities from the definition of "person," including automobile clubs, which have not been regulated by the Department since 2021. The Department believes the language "any other legal entity under the jurisdiction of the commissioner" best defines person for the purposes of this statute and prevents the Legislature from having to revisit this each time a change is made to the jurisdiction.

House Bill 2048 also amends K.S.A. 40–108 and 40–2253. These statutes contain requirements for the Commissioner of Insurance to make an annual report to the governor on the status of insurance companies in Kansas, and for the Commissioner to provide a report in 1993 concerning interstate electronic communication standards. The Kansas Department of Insurance publishes its annual report on the Department's website where all Kansans, including the Governor can access it. These statutes requiring the reports are outdated and unnecessary.

House Bill 2048 passed the House Committee of the Whole with a vote of 105-12.
