Subject: Bill Brief on SB 414

Senate Bill 414 authorizes the secretary of corrections to enter into a memorandum of understanding to provide money from the evidence-based programs account to residential facilities with behavioral health crisis intervention services for juveniles.

The bill amends K.S.A. 65-536, the statute that creates juvenile crisis intervention centers. Current law authorizes the secretary of corrections to enter into a memorandum of understanding with other cabinet agencies to provide funding, not to exceed \$2,000,000 annually from the evidence-based programs account of the state general fund for juvenile crisis intervention services. This bill would add that the services may be provided at a licensed juvenile crisis intervention center to another residential facility licensed by DCF or KDADS that has a program purpose of behavioral health crisis intervention for juveniles.
