Subject: Bill Brief on HB 2307

House Bill 2307 transfers the power to authorize and oversee certain activities regarding prenatal and postnatal diagnosed conditions awareness programs from the department of health and environment to the Kansas council on developmental disabilities.

Section 1 transfers the powers, duties and functions of prenatally and postnatally diagnosed conditions awareness programs as provided in K.S.A. 65-1,259 from the department of health and environment to the Kansas council on developmental disabilities.

Section 2 amends K.S.A. 65-1,259 to reflect the transfer from the department of health and environment to the Kansas council on developmental disabilities.

Section 2(g)(1) establishes the prenatally and postnatally diagnosed conditions awareness programs fund in the state treasury and sets out the allowable uses for this fund.

Section 2(g)(2) states that on July 1, 2025, the director of accounts and reports shall transfer \$25,000 from the state general fund to the prenatally and postnatally diagnosed conditions awareness programs fund.

HB 2307 would take effect on July 1, 2025, after publication in the statute book. The house committee made one technical amendment, and the bill passed the house on a vote of 122-0.
