Subject: Bill Brief on House Bill 2284

House Bill 2284 directs the department of administration to adopt written policies governing the negotiated procurement of managed care organizations to provide state medicaid services pursuant to a contract with the Kansas program of medical assistance.

Section 1 (b) states that such policy shall include a prohibition on the destruction of records, an adoption of a tiebreak procedure if the evaluation process involves scoring by individuals or committees and a requirement to be transparent with the legislature during each step of the procurement process.

The house committee added language in subsection (b)(4) to add an appeals process, which would be overseen by an appeals committee. Paragraph (4) sets out the membership of this appeals committee and that the committee shall oversee and adjudicate appeals in accordance with policies adopted by the department of administration.

Section 1 (c) states that the policies shall be adopted and implemented prior to July 1, 2026.

House Bill 2284 would take effect on July 1, 2025, after publication in the statute book and passed the house on a vote of 120-3.
