SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 322 by Joint Committee on Administrative Rules and Regulations

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 322 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 322 would remove the authority of the Board of Pharmacy to authorize individuals to access the Prescription Monitoring Program database by rules and regulations.

The Board of Pharmacy indicates there would be no fiscal effect if the bill is enacted. Also, the Board indicates the agency does not have any regulations that would be affected by the enactment of the bill.
