MEMORANDUM

Subject: House Bill No. 2029 (As Amended by House Committee)

Summary

House Bill No. 2029 designates a portion of K-5 Highway as the Rep Marvin S Robinson Memorial Highway and redesignates a current portion of the Harry Darby Memorial Highway for Interstate Highway 635.

Section 1 – provides that the Rep Marvin S Robinson Memorial Highway will be designated from the portion of K-5 Highway from the junction of K-5 Highway and North 18th Street in Wyandotte County, then west on K-5 Highway to the junction of North 38th Street. Highway signs designating the highway as the Rep Marvin S Robinson Memorial Highway will not be placed until the requirements of K.S.A. 68-10,114 are met. K.S.A. 68-10,114 provides that the Secretary of Transportation should not place any signs designating memorial highways until receiving sufficient funds from gifts and donations to cover the costs of those signs. Additionally, the Secretary must receive an additional 50% of the initial cost to pay for future maintenance or replacement costs for the signs.

Section 2 – redesignates that portion of K-5 Highway since it was already named to account for the Rep Marvin S Robinson Memorial Highway. That portion of the highway is currently designated as the Harry Darby Memorial Highway.
