## MEMORANDUM

Subject: House Bill 2221 – As Amended by House Committee

House Bill 2221 abolishes the department of corrections alcohol and drug abuse treatment fund, creates the Kansas department for aging and disability services alcohol and drug abuse treatment fund and transfer the moneys and liabilities from such abolished fund to the Kansas department for aging and disability services alcohol and drug abuse treatment fund.

Section 1 amends K.S.A. 8-1567, the crime of driving under the influence. Current law in subsection (q) directs certain fines to the community alcoholism and intoxication programs fund and the department of corrections alcohol and drug abuse treatment fund. The bill creates the Kansas department for aging and disability services alcohol and drug abuse treatment fund, transfers all the moneys in the department of corrections alcohol and drug abuse treatment fund, and, and abolishes the department of corrections alcohol and drug abuse treatment fund.

Section 2 amends K.S.A. 74-7336, the state concerning fines, penalties and forfeitures received from clerks of the district court by the state treasurer. House Bill 2221 changes the name of the fund in subsection (a)(4) to reflect the amendment made in section 1 of the bill. The bill becomes effective upon the publication in the statute book.

The House Committee on Corrections and Juvenile Justice amended to the bill for technical corrections. House Bill 2221 passed the House chamber 123-0 on February 2, 2025.
