

REPORTS OF STANDING COMMITTEES

MR. SPEAKER:

The Committee on **Health and Human Services** recommends **HB 2528** be amended on page 1, in line 19, by striking "related to" and inserting "based upon a violation of"; also in line 19, after "regulations" by inserting "that arises from or is related to applications for licensure or license renewal"; in line 21, after "(A)" by inserting "K.S.A. 65-1120(a)(6) prior to July 1, 2019," also in line 21, by striking the second "or" and inserting a comma; also in line 21, by striking ", K.S.A." and inserting "or"; in line 22, by striking all after "(1)"; in line 23, by striking all before the comma; also in line 23, by striking "K.S.A. 65-1120" and inserting a comma; in line 26, after "(B)" by inserting "K.A.R. 60-3-110(v) prior to April 29, 2016, K.A.R. 60-3-110(w) on or after April 29, 2016,"; also in line 26, by striking "60-3-110(w),"; in line 30, by striking "related to" and inserting "based upon a violation of"; in line 34, by striking "related to" and inserting "based upon";

On page 2, in line 9, by striking ", after being provided notice,";

On page 4, in line 2, by striking "one day" and inserting "five business days"; in line 29, after the period by inserting "A license shall remain valid and active during the 90-day period following the renewal date.

(C) A license canceled for failure to renew may be reinstated within three years of cancellation upon:

- (i) Approval of the board;
- (ii) payment of the renewal fees then due; and
- (iii) proof of compliance with the continuing educational requirements established by the

board by rules and regulations.

(D) A person who has not been in the active practice of the profession for which reinstatement is sought or has not been engaged in a formal educational program during the three years preceding the application for reinstatement may be required to complete such additional testing, training or education as the board may deem necessary to establish the licensee's present ability to practice with reasonable skill and safety.";

On page 11, in line 37, after the period by inserting:

Also on page 11, in line 41, after the comma by inserting "except as provided in this paragraph,";

On page 12, in line 2, after the period by inserting "An alleged violation that is not related to nor arising from the practice of nursing may be investigated by a board member or designee without such similar clinical or professional experience.

Also on page 12, in line 8, after the period by inserting:

"(3)";

Also on page 12, also in line 8, after "closed" by inserting "22 months"; in line 9, by striking "one calendar year from";

On page 15, in line 35, by striking "one"; in line 36, by striking "day" and inserting "five business days";

On page 18, in line 22, after "(2)" by inserting "A license shall remain valid and active during the 90-day period following the renewal date.

Also on page 18, in line 27, by striking "(3)" and inserting "(4)";

On page 19, in line 18, by striking "(1)"; by striking all in lines 37 and 38;

On page 22, in line 17, after "(b)" by inserting "Upon request,"; and the bill be passed as amended.
