MR. PRESIDENT:

I move to amend **SCR 1603**, As Amended by Senate Committee, on page 2, following line 30, by inserting:

"Each year, the approval by a majority of the qualified electors of the taxing entity voting at an election called and held thereon shall be required for the governing body of any taxing entity to increase its total amount of property tax to be levied by more than the annual rate of inflation, as reflected in the consumer price index for all urban consumers, or successor reports, as reported by the bureau of labor statistics of the United States department of labor, or its successor.";

On page 4, in line 27, after the period by inserting "The amendment would also require the approval by a majority of electors voting at an election in order for the governing body of any taxing entity to increase its total amount of property tax to be levied by more than the annual rate of inflation.";

On page 5, in line 13, after the stricken material by inserting "The amendment would also require the approval by a majority of electors voting at an election in order for the governing body of any taxing entity to increase its total amount of property tax to be levied by more than the annual rate of inflation.";

On page 1, in the title, in line 4, after "purposes" by inserting "; requiring elector approval for any taxing entity to increase its total amount of property tax to be levied by more than the annual rate of inflation"
