SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2209 by House Committee on Taxation

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2209 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2209 would clarify that the sales tax exemption for member agencies of the Kansas Coalition Against Sexual and Domestic Violence includes the entire program, including sexual violence programs. The bill would take effect on July 1, 2025.

The Department of Revenue indicates that the bill would not affect state revenues as its provisions are clarifying in nature. The Department estimates that revising sales tax publications would cost \$670 from the State General Fund in FY 2026. Any fiscal effect associated with HB 2209 is not reflected in *The FY 2026 Governor's Budget Report*.

The Kansas Association of Counties and the League of Kansas Municipalities indicate that the bill would have an unknown fiscal effect on local governments.
