SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2366 by House Committee on Health and Human Services

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2366 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2366 would amend the Naturopathic Doctor Licensure Act to expand the scope of naturopathic doctors. Naturopathic doctors would be authorized to order and perform certain examinations and diagnostic imaging studies; perform minor office procedures and naturopathic acupuncture; provide naturopathic care to a pregnant patient; prescribe, administer, or dispense certain prescription-only drugs; and provide other services as specified in the bill. The bill would also include restrictions on naturopathic doctors, update statutory definitions and provisions for consistency, and update licensure and disciplinary provisions.

The Kansas State Board of Healing Arts expects that any fiscal effect as a result of the enactment of HB 2366 would be negligible and absorbed within existing resources.
