SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2416 by Representative Delperdang

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2416 is respectfully submitted to your committee.


HB 2416 would enact the Kansas Motorsports Venue Protection Act. Under the bill, a racing facility or racetrack would be immune from liability in any civil action that is based on nuisance, taking, or similar legal theories if the racing facility or racetrack was located and established in Kansas before a surrounding property owner either: (1) purchased or acquired the surrounding property owner's real property; or (2) constructed improvements on the surrounding property owner's real property.

The immunity would not apply to a civil action alleging a martial violation of applicable state or local laws or a condition expressly prohibited by a valid permit governing the racing facility or racetrack. The bill would specify that nothing in its provisions would be construed to affect any civil action unrelated to nuisance, taking, or similar legal theories; or limit the enforcement authority of the state or any political subdivision of the state for violation of state or local laws unrelated to claims for nuisance, taking, or similar legal theories.

The Office of Judicial Administration indicates the bill's enactment would have a negligible fiscal effect on the operations of the Judicial Branch.

The Kansas Association of Counties indicates the bill could have a fiscal effect on Kansas counties; however, the Association cannot estimate a fiscal effect. The League of Kansas Municipalities states enactment of the bill would not have a fiscal effect on Kansas cities.
