
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2446 by House Committee on Elections

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2446 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Under current election laws, a political or other organization is required to list the treasurer of the organization sponsoring a political advertisement. HB 2446 would revise the definition of the crime of corrupt political advertising by deleting the requirement that the treasurer be listed in the advertising attributions.

The Public Disclosure Commission and the Office of the Judicial Administration indicate HB 2446 would not have a fiscal effect on agency operations. The Kansas Association of Counties and the Kansas League of Municipalities indicate passage of the bill would not have a fiscal effect on local government.
