SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2450 by House Committee on Elections


In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2450 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Under current law, if a candidate for office is not elected or decides not to be a candidate, the candidate's campaign account is automatically terminated. HB 2450 would create exceptions to the automatic termination of candidate campaign accounts if the account holds more than \$1,000 or has total liabilities of more than \$1,000.

The Public Disclosure Commission indicates HB 2450 would not have a fiscal effect. The Secretary of State indicates it would use existing resources to update training materials for local election officials and update educational and promotional materials for the public regarding the provisions of HB 2450. Any fiscal effect associated with HB 2450 is not reflected in *The FY 2027 Governor's Budget Report*.

The Kansas Association of Counties indicates HB 2450 would have no fiscal effect on counties.
