
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2461 by House Committee on Insurance

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2461 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2461 would become part of the Public Adjusters Licensing Act. The bill would prohibit a public adjuster from negotiating for or effectuating a settlement of any insurance claim for loss or damage arising from residential and personal lines of insurance.

The Kansas Department of Insurance states that it could see an increase in inquiries or requests for information requiring review and response. However, the Department would use existing staff to review and respond to those inquiries and any additional costs would be absorbed within the agency's existing budget. Any fiscal effect associated with HB 2461 is not reflected in *The FY 2027 Governor's Budget Report*.
