
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2486 by House Committee on Education

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2486 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2486 would require school districts to not enroll a child in kindergarten unless the child is toilet trained, with certain exceptions outlined in the bill. A school district would be required to receive written assurance from the parent or person acting as parent of that fact. The bill would require each school district to establish policy and procedures to address a kindergarten student who is found not to be toilet trained.

The Department of Education indicates that the enactment of the bill would have no fiscal effect on state aid to school districts or on administrative costs to the agency. The Kansas Association of School Boards indicates that the enactment of the bill would increase school districts' administrative costs related to enforcement of the bill's provisions. However, a fiscal effect cannot be estimated.
