SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2503 by Representative Reavis, et al.

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2503 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2503 would repeal the Mail Ballot Election Act, which authorizes the use of mail ballots for certain elections listed in the Act. The bill would also delete references to the Act in current statutes. The bill also makes technical corrections.

The Secretary of State indicates it would use existing resources to update training materials for local election officials regarding the provisions of HB 2503. Any fiscal effect associated with HB 2503 is not reflected in *The FY 2027 Governor's Budget Report*.

The Kansas Association of Counties indicates enactment of HB 2503 would increase costs to counties associated with filing election procedures for different county agencies having to shift from various mailing options to in-person voting only. However, the Association cannot estimate the fiscal effect.
