
**SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2510 by House Committee on K-12 Education Budget**

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2510 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2510 would require local boards of education to allocate any amount of membership association dues to individual board members. The bill would prohibit payment of dues allocated to a board member if a board member would elect not to join the membership association.

The Department of Education indicates the enactment of HB 2510 would have no fiscal effect on the agency. The Kansas Association of School Boards (KASB) states the bill would allow a local school board member to opt out of paying a member's allocated proportion of dues to KASB. The enactment of the bill could result in reduced revenues to KASB, depending on how many board members would opt out of the proportional dues to KASB. Reduced revenues to KASB could have school boards losing access to information provided by KASB, including policy services and legal representation, professional development for board members and district staff, and other services provided by KASB. However, a fiscal effect cannot be estimated.
